

**ANTICIPATED Q&As FOR THE PRESS RELEASE ON MEASLES IMMUNITY REQUIREMENTS FOR
MIGRANT DOMESTIC WORKERS (MDWs)**

Q1	Do all MDWs need to be vaccinated against measles?
A1	<p>Employers will only need to vaccinate their MDWs if (a) they are not immune to measles <u>and</u> (b) there is a child below 7 years old who is not fully vaccinated against measles in the household.</p> <p>Employers are also strongly encouraged to vaccinate or ascertain immunity of their MDWs if there are immunocompromised household members.</p>
Q2	How much will the measles vaccine cost?
A2	<p>The cost of measles vaccination for two doses is estimated to be \$80-\$140. Employers should check with their medical provider on the cost of immunisation.</p>
Q3	How will MOM detect and enforce against false declarations?
A3	<p>MOM will conduct sample checks and may request for documentary proof of immunity.</p> <p>If employers with children below 7 years old are found with MDWs who are not immune against measles, their work pass privileges may be suspended until vaccination proof is submitted.</p>
