







# SINGAPORE WORKPLACE SAFETY & HEALTH REPORT

Workplace safety performance for 2021 were comparable to pre-COVID levels in 2019.







Manufacturing, Construction and Transportation & Storage remained the top 3 sectors/industries with the most fatal and major injuries in 2021.
